#### WORK EXPERIENCE

##### **Product Designer**, Skyland Family, Berlin, 2020–2025

Skyland Family is an invitation-only investment platform for family offices and wealthy individuals.

I worked with the founders from day one, specifically, planned and executed the MVP in under 6 months, working closely with an overseas team of 4 software developers. During my tenure, the platform expanded, changed course, and eventually evolved into a complex digital product used primarily in the DACH region. I learnt a lot about the business model, the investment space, and the very peculiar audience we built for.

As the sole designer, I researched every feature idea, designed and conducted interviews, facilitated meetings and workshops, and created and iterated on prototypes. I engaged with the development team directly during handoff and sprint planning. It incentivised me to learn to manage projects, prioritise and maintain the backlog and embrace the scrum methodology. I made sure we collaborate effectively, reconciling business and members' needs, and launch features that are both usable and useful.

##### **Designer (Graphic, UX/UI)**, Bookster, Bucharest, 2015–2018

Bookster is a modern online library offered as an employment benefit by Romanian companies. It hosts a community of over 100K readers who use the platform to discover and borrow books. I joined when the company experienced exponential growth, about a year after its launch from a startup incubator.

For the first two years, I managed all visual touchpoints— the online library as well as all branded content for online and print. Later, I transitioned into a UX role in a cross-functional team focusing on User Retention. I owned the digital product, built new library features and iterated on them in a build-measure-learn framework. I conducted research and usability testing for signup and onboarding, always advocating for readers' success.

I also led several full-cycle campaigns, coordinating with freelancers, developers, account managers, external suppliers, and the logistics department. This is where I got comfortable with rapid prototyping and lean ways of working against defined KPIs.

##### **Graphic Designer**, AnnArt Gallery, Bucharest, 2014 – 2015

I managed graphic content for social media and newsletters, as well as printed invitations and posters. I also created an art catalogue, being accountable not just for layout and DTP, but also for the production, distribution, and launch.
